Safeguarding at SJR As promised in the Autumn newsletter, here is some more information about the need for a CRB disclosure for volunteers at SJR. If you help out with any children's or youth groups at SJR or you are a key holder, the Methodist Church requires that you hold a current CRB certificate. It is quite likely that there are a number of people who do not have one or have one that is more than five years old. The easiest way to solve this problem is to have a 'group' CRB form filling session. Therefore, following the General Church meeting on Sunday 8th November, CRB forms will be available for anyone who needs to complete one. You will need to bring some form of identification, ideally with a photograph on (passport or driving licence), but a birth certificate is also acceptable and two other additional items such as your birth certificate/marriage certificate and something with your address on (bank statement, utility bill, council tax bill, credit card statement, TV licence, vehicle registration document). Copies will be made to be sent away with your completed form. If you have any questions about this, please feel free to ask, and I will do my best to answer them!
